**Supplies:** Students will be supplied with *100 Bible Stories* and a folder for all of their class handouts and tests. Students should also plan on bringing their own NIV Bible.

**Behavior:** A behavior contract should be signed by both the student and their parents. It is important that students behave in such a way that learning and growth can be accomplished. If a youth misbehaves, the following system is used:

First Time: Youth is asked to stop misbehaving;

Second Time: A warning is given;

Third Time: A parent is called by the student from church.

**Memory Work:** The chart to the left outlines what memory work should be completed throughout the year. Each week we will work in class to memorize several important things: the Books of the Bible, the Ten Commandments and the Apostles Creed. These items should also be worked on at home to ensure memorization.

In addition to these catechism requirements, students will also be asked to memorize ten Bible verses each year. Each verse has been assigned a due date. If on that date the student can recite from memory BOTH the required and the preferred verses, they will receive one point. If they are able to recite all three, they will earn three points.

**Service Project:** Each student will be asked to do a minimum of 5 hours of free service for someone not in their immediate family, such as a teacher, grandparent, pastor, church or a neighbor. Serving as an usher, an acolyte, on altar guild, or in Children's Church will count. These hours are due prior to the confirmation retreat on **February 20<sup>th</sup>**.

**Testing:** There will be two tests given to assess the learning process. The first will be given prior to Christmas break on **December 19<sup>th</sup>**; the second will be given prior to the end of confirmation classes on **March 26<sup>th</sup>**.
